

# PICKLEBALL COURT MEASUREMENTS

## CHEAT SHEET



KNOW THE DIMENSIONS. PLAY WITH CONFIDENCE!



### 1. COURT SIZE

The total court size is 20 feet wide by 44 feet long.



### 2. NET HEIGHT

The net height is 36 inches at the sidelines and 34 inches at the center.



### 3. NON-VOLLEY ZONE (KITCHEN)

The non-volley zone extends 7 feet from the net on both sides of the court.



### 4. NON-VOLLEY ZONE WIDTH

The non-volley zone is the same width as the court: 20 feet.



### 5. BASELINE TO NON-VOLLEY ZONE

The distance from the baseline to the non-volley zone line is 15 feet.



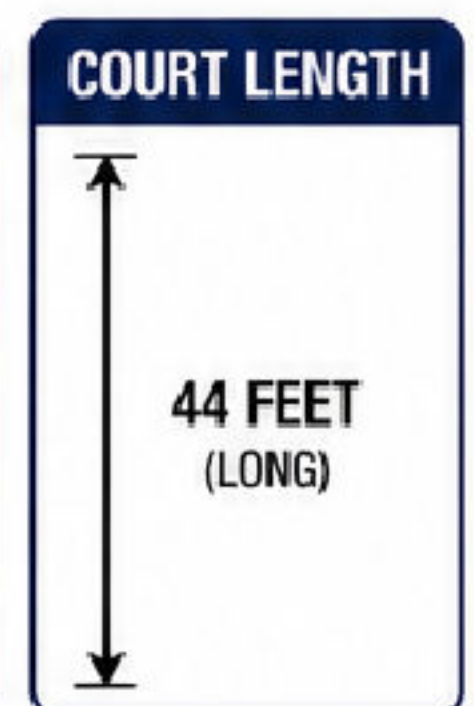
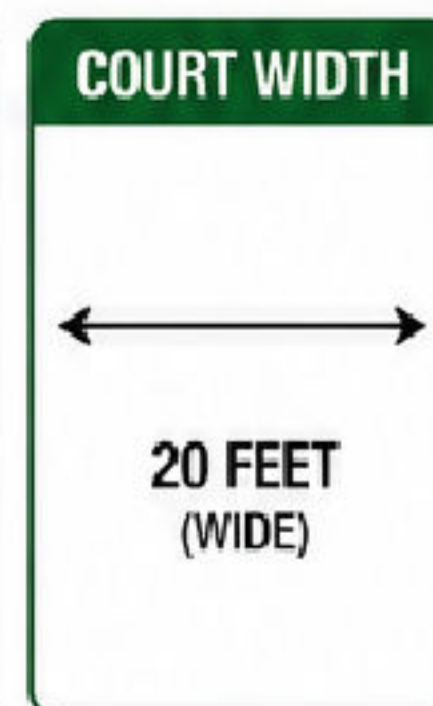
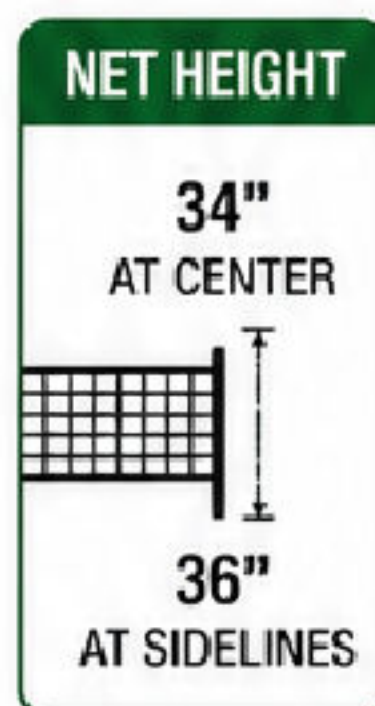
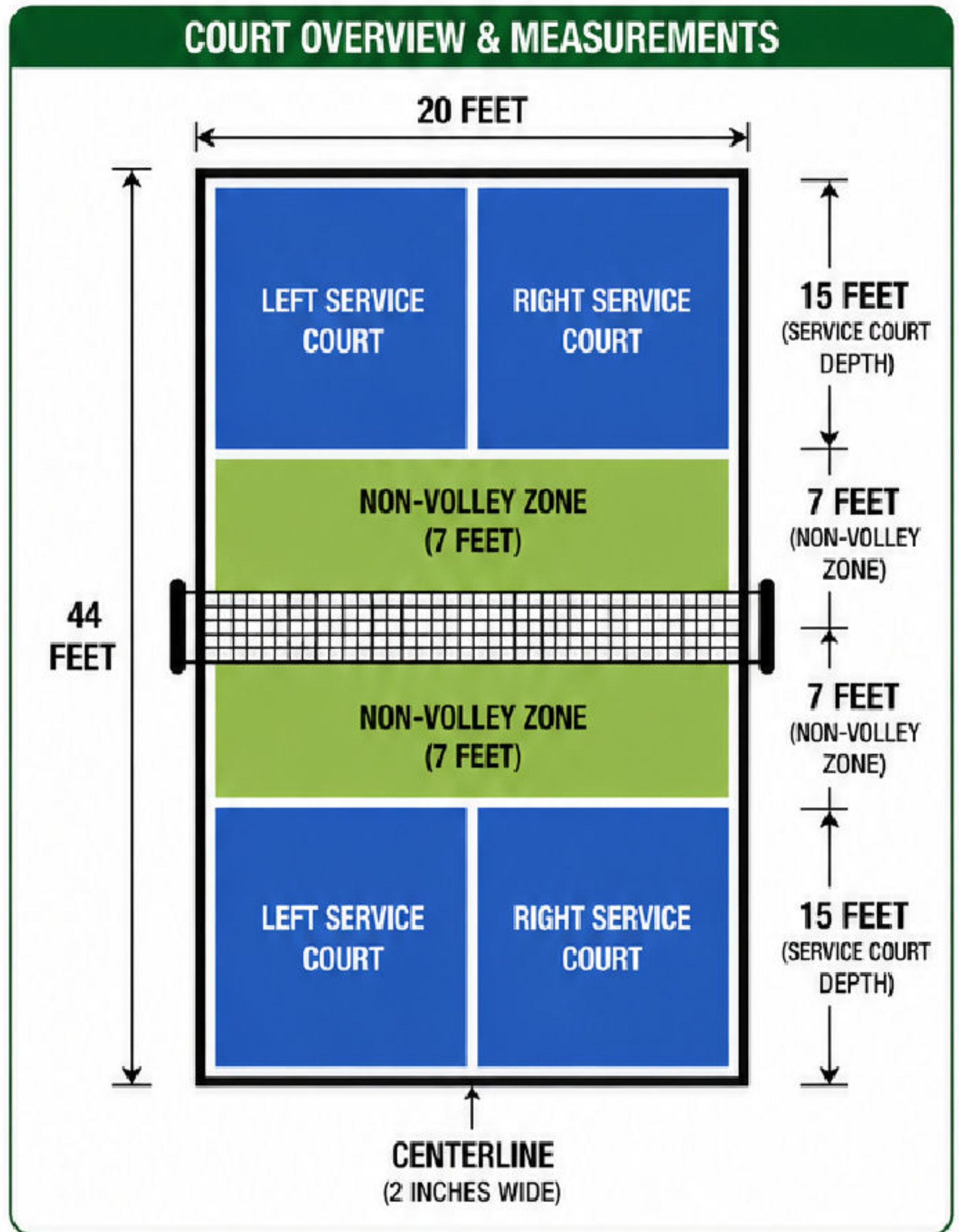
### 6. SERVICE COURT DEPTH

Each service court (measured from the non-volley zone line to the baseline) is 15 feet deep.



### 7. CENTERLINE

The centerline divides the court into left and right service courts. It is 2 inches wide.



### QUICK REFERENCE

- ✓ Total Court Size: 20 feet wide x 44 feet long
- ✓ Non-Volley Zone: 7 feet from the net on both sides
- ✓ Service Court Depth: 15 feet (from NVZ line to baseline)
- ✓ Net Height: 36 inches at sidelines, 34 inches at center
- ✓ Centerline Width: 2 inches

### IMPORTANT NOTES

- All measurements are in feet and inches.
- Lines are 2 inches wide on the court.
- Use these measurements for setting up courts at home, in the community, or at tournaments.
