

# HOW TO CLEAN A PICKLEBALL PADDLE



A CLEAN PADDLE = BETTER SPIN, MORE CONTROL, LONGER LIFE

## STEP-BY-STEP CLEANING GUIDE



### 1 REMOVE LOOSE DIRT

Wipe the paddle face with a dry microfiber cloth to remove dust, dirt, and surface debris.



### 2 PREPARE A GENTLE SOLUTION

Mix mild dish soap with warm water. You only need a few drops of soap.



### 3 GENTLY CLEAN THE SURFACE

Dampen a soft cloth or sponge with the soapy water and gently wipe the paddle face. Use light pressure—don't scrub.



### 4 RINSE WITH CLEAN WATER

Dampen a clean cloth with plain water and wipe the paddle to remove any soap residue.



### 5 DRY THOROUGHLY

Use a dry microfiber towel to dry the paddle completely. Let it air dry fully before using or storing.



### 6 STORE PROPERLY

Store your paddle in a cover in a cool, dry place away from extreme heat or cold.

## CLEANING TIPS

- ✓ Clean your paddle regularly for the best performance.
- ✓ Wipe your paddle after playing in dusty, sweaty, or humid conditions.
- ✓ Use a microfiber cloth—it's gentle and won't scratch the surface.
- ✓ Keeping your paddle clean helps maintain spin, control, and durability.

## WHAT TO AVOID

- ✗ Do not use bleach, acetone, or ammonia-based cleaners.
- ✗ Do not put your paddle in the dishwasher or washing machine.
- ✗ Do not soak your paddle in water.
- ✗ Avoid using rough brushes or abrasive materials.
